The longest running and most beloved of these programs is Camp Civitan, a 15-acre wheelchair accessible camp located in Williams, Arizona. Since 1968, Camp Civitan has provided those with developmental disabilities the opportunity to engage in a variety of enriching and fun experiences that promote positive self-esteem, socialization and teamwork; including but not limited to adaptive educational and physical activities, community field trips, arts and crafts, nutrition classes, gross and fine motor skill training, and peer socialization. As an intern, you will team with experienced program leaders to create, plan and provide a variety of educational programs for campers; both children and adults with developmental disabilities. This position is designed to guide interns in developing valuable teaching skills, knowledge, and experience as they work closely with program leaders, staff, and participants. Strong applicants will be creative, flexible and dependable undergraduates working towards a degree, with a sincere interest in art education. Experience working with individuals with special needs is preferred but not required. A strong work ethic, excellent interpersonal skills and the ability to work well with a team are essential for this position. Housing and meals for the entire summer are provided. College credit may be applied for through your school. Each intern will also be assigned to a program leader who will mentor, oversee, and support the intern as well as serve as a professional resource throughout the summer.

Dates: June 11, 2011 - August 15, 2011.

Hours: Interns are expected to be at camp at all times, but will be allotted time off in 24 hour segments. Interns will receive one 24 hour segment off each week. Time off requests longer than 24 hours must be approved in advance by the Camp Director.

Duties:

- Assist in the development of exciting and unique adapted art projects for individuals with special needs.
- Assist with project preparation.
- Assist clients and staff with adapted art projects.
- Assist in the maintenance of facilities, supplies, and inventory.
- Assist with other camp operations as necessary.

Qualifications:

- Undergraduate student with a sincere interest in art education.
- Must be at least 18 years old.
- Must demonstrate empathy and understanding of the challenges faced by individuals with disabilities.
- Some experience working with special needs individuals preferable but not required.
- Creative, flexible and able to work closely with designated mentor.
- Ability to work as a team member.
- Strong work ethic, punctual, dependable, ability to work long hours.
- Excellent interpersonal skills with staff, children, and parents.
- Must be able to comply with and maintain a smoke-free and drug-free work environment.

 Must meet agency licensure requirements for fingerprinting, CPR and First Aid, and Article 9 state mandated training by start date.
